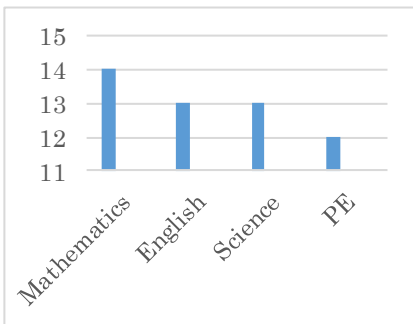

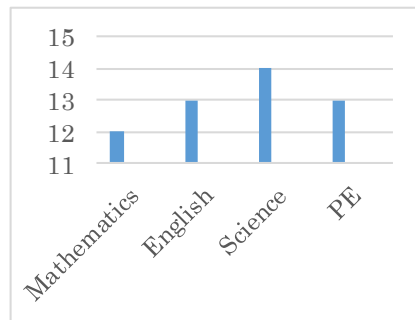

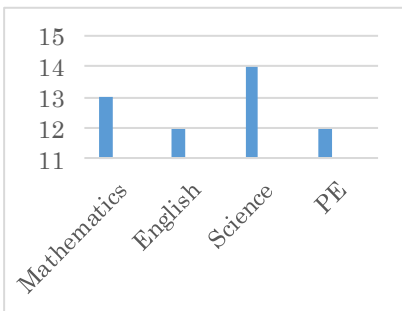

Alex: (b) Couldn't be better. I heard you aren't going to come to Sydney this year.

Yuji: Yes, because of the Covid 19 pandemic*, we can't visit you.

Alex: I know, (c) [bad / can't / I / it's / see / that / too / you]. But thanks to technology, we can have a conversation like this face to face.

Yuji: Yes, you can say that again. But, I still feel sad I cannot visit Sydney. There was some good news, though. We almost gave up holding it but we were able to hold the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

Alex: Yes! I watched some on TV. In spite of the pandemic, athletes were able to visit Tokyo to attend the Olympics. That was very good news. Australia did quite well, especially in swimming. We won 17 golds, 7 silvers, and 22 bronzes. I heard Japan won lots of medals. How many medals did Japan win?

Yuji: golds, silvers, and bronzes. A total of 58 medals.

Alex: golds? That's ten more gold medals than Australian athletes won.

It was a fine, sunny day in June. Since there were no trees, the wind was strong and wild, like lion. I had to move on. I could not stay there.

I walked on for five hours, and still could not find any water. I began to lose hope. Everything around me was dry, very dry. Then, far away in the distance, I thought it was (b) something small and dark. Was it a tree? I started walking towards* it. It was a man, and he was with his sheep. There were about thirty of them.

He gave me some of his water, and I felt much better. He then took me to his little house. The man did not say very much. People who live alone are often like that. And he was not afraid at all. (c) That was a little strange since there was no one else in this wild country.

He lived in a real house. It was made of stone and strongly built. It was strong and safe. And the sound of the wind against it was like the sound of the sea. Inside, . I noticed that the dishes were washed and the floor was clean. His soup was cooking over the fire. He gave me a bowl of* it. I looked at him again. His clothes were very neat. He did not smoke. He had a dog. It was quiet, too, friendly, and not afraid.

(d) We both understood that I would have to spend the night there. The nearest village was a day and a half away. I also knew that life was hard in the few villages in that part of the country. There were four or five of them, but quite far apart. Families lived together in small houses. Their lives were empty*, and nobody was happy. Of course, it was not easy to live in such a place. In addition, the weather was bad both in winter and summer. And there was a very strong wind which never stopped. The people who lived there could only wait to die or go mad*.
